

I've signed up for Cub Scouts – Now What?

Uniform Requirements:

Scout:

- Blue Cub Scout button up shirt (referred to as Class A). Short sleeve will work all year (wear long sleeve t-shirt underneath in winter). Appx. \$23
- World crest patch (purple fleur-de-lis). Appx. \$2
- Pack 619 patch available from the Pack (or individual numbers). Appx. \$5
- Neckerchief slide. Appx. \$3 – or you may be making one with your den.
- Glacier's Edge council patch. Appx. \$5
- Advancement book for the appropriate age (Tiger – 1st grade, Wolf – 2nd grade, Bear – 3rd grade, Webelos – 4th and 5th grade).
- Optional:
 - Pack (or other scouting) tee shirt (referred to as Class B). Appx. \$12
 - Baseball hat. Appx. \$5
 - Cub scout belt. Appx. \$9

Pack supplied:

- Neckerchief

Adult Den Leader:

- Tan button-up shirt
- World crest patch
- Pack 619 patch available from the Pack (or individual numbers)
- Glacier's Edge council patch
- Den leader insignia patch
- Square knot patches (if prior scout), various ones for different achievements.
- Neckerchief & slide
- Optional:
 - Scouting hat
- Get an extra copy of the Tiger cub advancement book to refer to for advancement requirements.
- Cub Scout Leader's book – has advancement, dues, attendance, uniform, etc. forms.

Uniforms can be found at the scout office in Rockford (1800 7th Ave), Janesville (2300 E. Racine St.), or at HobbyTown (3782 N. Alpine Rd.).

What's Next?

- We have to split the kids up into dens and let the den leader's know their additions, or form a new den. We must get all your contact information correctly in order to be able to communicate with you. Email is the preferred method. If you are not an "emailer", PLEASE LET US KNOW TO CONTACT YOU VIA PHONE.
- If you have volunteered to be a den leader, or co-leader, first of all THANK YOU! You are helping to make your son's experience a great one. Again, we must have an adult application for you in order to register you with the National Boy Scouts of America.
- After we figure out the dens, you should get some contact from your den leader to introduce themselves and arrange the den meetings. There are typically one to two a month. Be patient if it is September, as registration, school startup, and den rearranging can be quite confusing! If you haven't heard from your den leader in September, don't fret – come to our pack meeting anyway. We will arrange you there and you will probably meet your den leader.
